

Call for Artists
Chillicothe & Ross County Public Library
Pop Culture Show
March 15 – April 15, 2019

Who: Any artist may participate.

What: All artwork must be original work. Limit two entries per artist, +1 entry for WeGeek art vendors.

When:

- Application deadline: February 28 (please include photos of your work with your application)
- Artwork installation: March 10 – 16 (Building assignments and available times will be communicated to artists following the application deadline.)
- Opening Reception: March 18
- WeGeek at the Library: March 30
- Artwork Pick-up: April 16 - 19

Where: The opening reception will be held at the Main Library Annex, with additional work displayed at the Main Library and at Northside Branch.

How: Please fill out the application on the following page and return to the library by February 28, 2019, attention: Liz (or e-mail art@crcpl.org)

Artists will be expected to display their own works in the location selected by library staff. In order to be displayed in the library, works of art should be properly prepared for installation. Two-dimensional works should be framed and three-dimensional works must have a pedestal or appropriate hanging apparatus or be appropriately designed to sit directly on the floor without posing a safety hazard. Hanging systems are available in each location, and artists may not use any additional hardware that causes damage to library property. Please make a copy of your application, and affix the label for each work to the back of that item.

Why: The Pop Culture Show complements CRCPL's ongoing Art Exhibit program, as well as our WeGeek event in late March. This type of showcase brings a community of artists together on a given topic, and helps introduce our patrons to a variety of art.

There is no fee for entry. No prices should be affixed to items. A list of prices for patrons may be obtained at the library front desk. No exhibited items can be sold through the library or library staff.
